## Ninth sea turtle fest Saturday at Gumbo Limbo center

With four exhibit tanks to show off, a new Neptune mural and tours of the sea turtle rehab, the city's Gumbo Limbo Nature Center is ready for its closeup on Saturday at the ninth annual Sea Turtle Day Festival.

The hours are from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m., rain or shine. Admission is free with a \$5 donation requested and \$3 for a bracelet for all crafts and activities. All parking is in Spanish River Park this year. Visitors are reminded to bring cash to buy food from food trucks or merchandise from vendors; there's no ATM on the premises.

"We have four very

The authors are chosen to appeal to a crosssection of festival goers.

"We try to bring a mix of current events, literature and thought-provoking ideas," Brown said in an email.

"So this year, we have [James] Fallows, who will talk on China, which is an important topic right now. We have three speakers who will enhance our understanding of what it means to be human: Daniel Levitin on 'Your Brain on Music': Barbara Schmidt on 'Vicktor Frankl's Man's Search for Meaning'; and National Humanities Award winner Anna Deavere Smith on 'Finding Grace Through Adversity.'

"Our quality of speakers is very high, and we feel that there is something of interest for everyone," Brown said.
