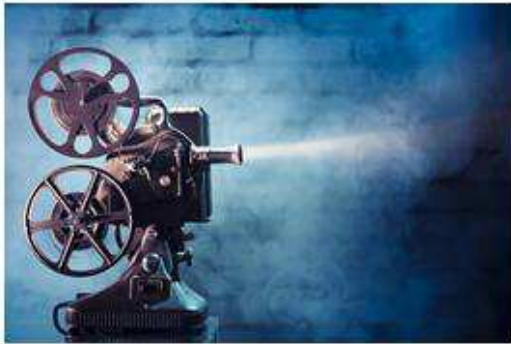


Boca honors veterans

A special tribute is planned at 9 a.m. at the Boca Raton Cemetery, 449 SW 4th Avenue, with the Boca Raton High School NJROTC, Boca Raton Community High School Band, Boca Raton Elks Lodge #2166, US Coast Guard Auxiliary, Estahakee Chapter NSDAR, American Legion Post #277, American Legion

Auxiliary Post #277. Mayor Susan Haynie will share a presentation of remembrances and welcome a special appearance by the Fort Lauderdale Highlanders. A special concert, "An American Tribute," will be presented by the Florida Wind Symphony under the direction of Dr. Kyle Prescott at 7 p.m. at the Mizner Park Amphitheater, 590 Plaza Real, in Downtown Boca.
