'Star Wars' score comes to life

Into the garbage chute, fly boy: "Star Wars: A New Hope in Concert" is bringing visual spectacle and composer John Williams' sweeping space-opera music to Miami and Boca Raton.

While Luke Skywalker, Han Solo, Obi-Wan Kenobi and Princess Leia clash with Darth Vader on the big screen, an 81-piece orchestra will perform Williams' Oscar-winning score onstage live on March 3 at the Adrienne Arsht Center for the Performing Arts in Miami.

Tickets for the screening and concert will go on sale to the public at noon Friday, Jan. II, and cost \$49-\$99 via ArshtCenter.org and the Arsht Center box office (305-949-6722).

So how is this different from a regular "Star Wars" screening?

Here's how it works: "Star Wars: A New Hope," which will be projected onstage, will have its soundtrack moved and replaced by the live 81-piece orchestra, who will recreate iconic tracks such as the soaring, epic "Main Title" and the jaunty "Cantina Band" from the orchestra pit.

Longtime "Star Wars" fanatics know that Williams' Oscar-winning 1977 soundtrack is just as timeless as the movie itself, which turned 40 years old in 2017 and has spawned eight sequels. In 2005, the American

Film Institute named the original "Star Wars" soundtrack the greatest American movie score of all time. Meanwhile, the J.J. Abrams-directed "Star Wars: Episode IX" is due in theaters on Dec. 20.

Wait. There's more "Star Wars"?

Where have you been, under a rock on Tatooine?

Not only is the sequel nearly finished, but there's a second "Star Wars: A New Hope in Concert" coming in March. The concert,

coinciding with the Festival of the Arts Boca, will take place at 7:30 p.m. March 1 at Mizner Park Amphitheater in Boca Raton. Members of the Symphonia Boca Raton will re-create the score under the baton of conductor Constantine Kitsopoulos

Prices are slightly cheaper here, too: \$35-\$150 via FestivalBoca.org and the box office (866-571-2787).
